Visual literacy is about language, communication and interaction. Visual media is a linguistic tool with which we communicate, exchange ideas and navigate our complex world. The term "visual literacy" was defined in 1969 by John Debes, the founder of the International Visual Literacy Association, as:

Visual decoding processes are also a large part of literacy learning. Some of the visual elements that are part of both literacy and music are the knowledge of letters, words, and sentences, visual focus, and visual memory (Hansen et al., 2004). Hands on Literacy Activities

Link literacy to student's special interests. Make explicit connections to student's prior experiences (e.g. texts already read, television shows, movies, games, etc.). Individualize instruction and adapt text to meet student's needs (e.g. add visuals at sentence or paragraph levels, alter passage length, present text in a variety of ...

Balanced Literacy Model Used in Many Classrooms

In addition, a literacy strategy for struggling readers comes from Suzy Pepper Rollins book Learning in the Fast Lane. She introduces the idea of TIP charts, used to introduce a lesson's vocabulary. Students may have access to these charts that are set up in three columns: Terms (T) Information (I) and Pictures (P).
