At a mean follow-up period of 35 months, a recurrence rate of 14% was reported in the open group and 18%, in the laparoscopic group (P = .30). The size of the defect was found to be an independent predictor for recurrence ( P < .001).

Recurrence was significantly more common after laparoscopic repair than after open repair of primary hernias (10.1 percent vs. 4.0 percent), but rates of recurrence after repair of recurrent ...

### Open Mesh versus Laparoscopic Mesh Repair of Inguinal Hernia

Laparoscopic inguinal hernia surgery needs a few small incisions whereas open surgery needs a long incision. In laparoscopic surgery, the recovery time is faster as compared to open surgery. General anesthesia is needed for laparoscopic repair whereas open surgery can be done under general, spinal or local anesthesia.

### Laparoscopic techniques versus open techniques to repair ...

The two major types of hernia surgery are traditional open surgery, and laparoscopic surgery. No one approach is suitable for every patient. Patients with certain types of hernias may benefit from open hernia surgery while another similar patient may need laparoscopic hernia repair.

In most cases, the open approach is the best and safest way to repair an incisional hernia. However, there are situations in which patients may benefit from the laparoscopic approach. The results comparing single laparoscopic and open single hernia repairs can be seen in Table 2. The surgical time is 66.57 minutes vs 40.21 minutes, recovery room time is 138.64 minutes vs 67.57 minutes, and charge is \$2190.07 vs \$925.25 for laparoscopic vs open procedure.

### Laparoscopic Versus Open Inguinal Hernia Repair in ...

Open Surgery Versus Laparoscopy in hernia repair. A hernia is a hole through the muscle layers in the abdominal wall. Therefore, surgery can be performed from either the abdominal side, as in the laparoscopic approach, or through the skin, as in a traditional, open approach.

### Open surgery versus laparoscopy in hernia repair ...

The hernia is repaired (with suturing or placing a synthetic mesh over the hernia in one of the layers of the abdominal wall) using either open surgery or minimal access laparoscopy. The most common laparoscopic techniques for inguinal hernia repair are transabdominal preperitoneal (TAPP) repair and totally extraperitoneal (TEP) repair.
