A data macro allows you to automate tasks and add functionality directly to your tables. Data macros and their actions are attached to specific table events such as when you add a new record to a table.

By calling the macro from other macros, you can avoid duplicating the same code in multiple places. On the Create tab, in the Macros & Code group, click Macro. Access opens the Macro Builder. On the Quick Access Toolbar, click Save. In the Save As dialog box, type a name for the macro, and then click OK.

Create a user interface (UI) macro - Access

Perform system-level actions You can carry out the RunApp action in a macro to run another program (such as Microsoft Excel) from within Access, but you can't use a macro to do much else outside of Access. By using VBA, you can check to see whether a file exists on the computer, use Automation or Dynamic Data Exchange (DDE) to communicate with other Microsoft Windows-based programs, such as Excel, and call functions in Windows dynamic-link libraries (DLLs).

If you name a macro Autoexec, Microsoft Access automatically runs it when your database opens. You can also open Microsoft Access from a command line and specify a macro name after the /x switch to run it when it opens. For instance, you can run the macro named MyMacro like this:

Running VBA Code from a Microsoft Access Macro using RunCode

When a database starts, Access runs the AutoExec macro before it runs any other macros or VBA code. Create an AutoExec macro. If you have already created a macro that contains the actions that you want to occur when the database starts, just rename the macro to AutoExec, and it will run the next time that you open the database. Otherwise, follow these steps to create a macro: On the Create tab, in the Other group, click Macro.

When you choose the Macro button on the Developer tab, it opens the Macros dialog box, which gives you access to VBA subroutines or macros that you can access from a particular document or application. The Visual Basic button opens the Visual Basic Editor, where you create and edit VBA code.

Save and then close the macro. When the database opens, the AutoExec macro starts and then tests the IsTrusted condition. If the database is not trusted by Access, the macro opens the form that you specified in the OpenForm action of the macro.
