He spends roughly two thirds of his book, The Anti-Education Era, telling us so. He describes how our thoughts aren't totally our own, but are influenced by many things. We are cautioned to be aware of who associate with, because "which minds to plug and play with gives life meaning" (p. 165). Gee tells us that school isn't doing what it's supposed to, that "school is not often based on problem solving, but on learning information, facts, and formulas" (p. 17).
