Before becoming a prophet, Amos was a sheep herder and a sycamore fig farmer. His prior professions and his claim "I am not a prophet nor a son of a prophet" (7:14) indicate that Amos was not from the school of prophets, which Amos claims would qualify him as a true prophet.

If the sons had not been wanted as walking witnesses to the prophet's forebodings, posterity would not know of this wife or these sons. Of Isaiah's parental home it is known only that his father's name was Amoz. Since he often spoke with kings, it is sometimes suggested that Isaiah was an aristocrat, possibly even of royal stock.

Who was among the sheepbreeders of Tekoa: it seems that Amos had no formal theological or prophetic training, though there was a school of the prophets known as the sons of the prophets at that time (1 Kings 20:35, 2 Kings 2:3-15, 2 Kings 4:1, 2 Kings 4:38). Amos was a simple man, a farmer, who had been uniquely called to ministry.

Amos had not been unemployed, with no other option but to become a prophet. On the contrary, he was a most successful shepherd in Tekoa and a grower of sycamore-fig fruit (1:1 ; 7:14). It was the Lord who "took" him from tending the flock and the orchards and commanded him, "Go, prophesy to my people Israel" (7:15).

Isaiah is counted among the four eminent Hebrew prophets who addressed the citizens of Judah and Israel in the latter half of the 8th century BC. According to verse 1, Amos tells us that he was a contemporary of Uzziah and Jeroboam II and prophesied "in the days of Uzziah, King of Judah (790-739 b.c.), and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash, King of Israel (793-753 b.c), two years before the earthquake" (1:1). Amos probably prophesied in the period from 767-753.
