A tow hitch (or tow bar or trailer hitch in North America) is a device attached to the chassis of a vehicle for towing, or a towbar to an aircraft nose gear. It can take the form of a tow ball to allow swiveling and articulation of a trailer, or a tow pin, or a tow hook with a trailer loop, often used for large or agricultural vehicles where slack in the pivot pin allows similar movements.

Dry hitch weight - The dry hitch weight is the amount of weight put on the trailer ball of your towing vehicle when the trailer is unloaded of water and gear. This number is usually quite low-about 10% of the total weight of the trailer. For my 25' trailer, the dry hitch weight is under 500 pounds.

Trailer classes are separated by: Gross Trailer Weight, the maximum weight of the trailer and its cargo combined. Gross Tongue Weight, the maximum weight exerted on the hitch ball by the coupler (usually around 10% of the Gross Trailer Weight). Hitch type, which includes weight-carrying and weight-distributing hitches.
