After repotting, make sure to keep your Bonsai in a mostly shaded area for 2-3 weeks. Water and mist your Bonsai, but don't water too much if your Bonsai don't have too many leaves. Don't use any fertilizer for at least 3-4 weeks. After this, choose a higher nitrogen or organic fertilizer to boost foliage growth.

Larix Bonsai and Pseudolarix can be attacked by mealy bugs, black aphids, tiny aphids which leave kinked and drying needles, caterpillars, bark beetle larvae, gall midges, saw fly and fungal diseases like grey mold rot and needle cast. Use a specific pesticide and try to improve your tree's living conditions.
